



City of Berkeley Public Financing Disclosure

The limit for any type of contribution to a candidate participating in the Public Financing Program is \$50.

Each contribution believed eligible for public funds must be accompanied by a Qualified Contribution Receipt as specified in BMC § 2.12.500A.3.a.: Each qualified contribution shall be acknowledged by a receipt to the contributor, with a copy retained by the candidate. The receipt shall include the contributor's signature, printed name, home address, and telephone number, if any, and the name of the candidate on whose behalf the contribution is made. In addition, the receipt shall indicate by the contributor's signature that the contributor understands that the purpose of the qualified contribution is to help the candidate qualify for Fair Elections campaign funding and that the contribution is made without coercion or reimbursement. Receipts must be accompanied by supporting documentation appropriate to the type of contribution – copy of check, electronic receipt, cash receipt, etc. You must also collect information required under BERA in BMC §§ 2.12.280, including the contributor's occupation and employer; if self-employed, you must also record the city in which the business is located.
